

## APPLICATION FOR NORDIC NETWORK FOR GIFTED EDUCATION TRAVEL SUPPORT 2023

The Nordic Network for Gifted Education (NNGE) has received (limited) funding 2022-4 from the Swedish Research Council to support building and maintaining Nordic connections in gifted education. The majority of money for 2023 will be allocated to support members to visit other Nordic countries, following a selection process. A total of approximately 50,000 SEK is available per Nordic country, to be distributed between as many people as possible.

### Eligibility and guidelines.

- eligible individuals are those identified as NNGE members on the website
- travel is only for visits to **Nordic** countries.
- travel must be in association with identified **research** activities
- funding support is for a maximum of a working week from NNGE (but can be combined with other funding support if applicants intend to stay longer), however shorter visits mean that support can be spread to more people.
- An equal spread of funding allocation across all five Nordic countries will be sought, however if places not used THEN then un-used money can be re-allocated to other countries
- reimbursement can only be paid in response to an invoice from companies, eg. Universities or businesses, not to private accounts.
- Country coordinators will evaluate proposals in the first instance, with the NNGE coordinating group making final decisions together.
- successful applicants who receive funding should report to NNGE on the product/outcome

- Applications need be on one single A4 page, containing the following information.

### Proposal content (one page)

- **name/s** (if a group list all names but identify a contact person)
- contact **email**
- **current position/role**
- proposed **visit location** (where?)
- proposed **contact person** (if relevant) ... have you made contact already with this person?
- proposed **visit date/s** (if you have a suggestion ... open-ended is also OK )
- what **research activities** will be engaged with in this visit?
- perceived **benefit and expected outcomes**, and how learning from the experience can be **shared with others** within and beyond the network
- **proposed cost** for the travel and accommodation and any other costs (if you have co-financing indicate this to make it clear the amount requested from NNGE)
- **label application emails** with the header 'NNGE travel application' followed by the name of the country you are travelling FROM (NOT where you are travelling TO)
- **label your document** with your name and the country you are travelling FROM.

### Examples of possible activities (not an exclusive list)

Research colleagues from two countries meeting together to trial a tool which will be used in a research project, or to analyse data, or to collaboratively conduct interviews, or a combination of research presentation and research meetings to specialised services  
50,000 might support five people with 10k each, or seven people with 7k each, or a combination of some people with higher and some with lower amounts depending on need.
